- 83 A reliable air service is absolutely imperative
- 84 Vital that the direct Alderney UK link is maintained, travel via Guernsey is inconvenient and too expensive.
- 85 Flight delayed
- 86 Weather disrupted journey, staff very helpful resceduled to a later flight same day
- 87 very few options for travel to Alderney, relatively expensive and weather reliant
- 88 would only come again if travel was more reliable and certain, too uncertain at present
- 89 more flights, less delays, third attempt to make medical appointment, delayed until appointment time
- 90 main reason for not visiting is cost of getting here, would come more frequently if costs were less
- 91 we were only able t visit this wonderful island as a relative paid for flight costs. The size of the boat, although cheaper, was not suitable for our toddler.
- 92 flights were part of the package we booked which included accommodation and some meals
- 93 The airport terminal buildings need replacing with a modern fit for purpose structure to meet the travel expectations and experience of todays travellers

- 106 Lack of flights required me to travel at inconvenient times
- 107 Delayed by weather coming out. Delayed no explanation leaving so missed connections AGAIN plenty of time allowed to catch connections
- 108 Have missed my ongoing connection due to 'tech' a disgraceful way to fun an airline
- 109 Urgent medical treatment had to be cancelled
- 110 Aldernev is a beautiful island and we had a very enjoyable weekend with our friends. But we had a two hour flight delay Guernsey to Alderney and a two hour flight delay Alderney to Guernsey. The airline is letting the island down.
- 111 Once again delayed flight, what is happening to this airline
- 112 Flybe caused us to miss our connecting flight from Southampton to Alderney, pity not another airline
- 113 The continual increase in charges could make my visits cost prohibitive. Any change in the Southampton route would also make it difficult to come over

- 152 No availability for Aurigny flights, would be nice to see more flights and more reasonable prices. Later opening/closing times for supermarkets especially during busy periods
- 153 I will always travel back but Alderney needs to find a way to provide reliable, cost effective travel to the UK. It's cheaper for a private plane making two trips
- 154 I used to work off island on Guernsey on a weekly basis but have had to resign that job due to the cost and unavailability of travel
- 155 Delayed late and left late would like to congratulate on consistency
- 156 Can we have more available accommodation for the busy periods and cheaper flights. If I didn't know the island already and have family here I wouldn't pay as much as we do to come here
- 157 More availability and accomodation during busy periods. Cheaper flight prices. More likely to come over more often if flights were cheaper
- 158 More regular and reliable air service would be welcome and lower air fares
- 159 air travel is expensive especially for a family
- 160 Flight was delayed due to Dornier not being able to fly with low cloud. Had to come the next day
- 161 Get the airlines working more efficiently and less expensive and my family and I would come more make it easier to rent out our property when we are not here
- 162 Cheaper flights
- 163 You need a ferry

- 176 Problems with the weather are understandable but when a plane goes 'tech' as often happens this can hide a number of reasons not known to passengers.
- 177 High fares make alderney the preserve of the rich: not even middle income earners will come very often
