NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 16 December 2016 at 09h30 Reassure Life Limited (formerly Guardian Assurance Limited) ("**RLL**") and ReAssure Limited ("**ReAssure**") intend to apply to the Royal Court of Guernsey, pursuant to section 44 of the Insurance Law, for an Order sanctioning a scheme (the "**Guernsey Scheme**") for the transfer to ReAssure of the entire long term insurance businesses carried on by RLL in Guernsey and all assets and liabilities attributable thereto (the "**Guernsey Business**") and for the making of ancillary provisions in connection with the implementation of the Guernsey Scheme under section 48 of the Insurance Law (the "**Application**").

The proposed transfer will result in the Guernsey Business which is currently carried on by RLL being carried on by ReAssure. All annuity payments in respect of the policies comprised within the Guernsey Business shall, upon the transfer becoming effective, be dealt with by ReAssure.

Copies of the Application, the report on the terms of the Guernsey Scheme prepared by an Independent Expert in accordance with section 45(2)(a) of the Insurance Law (the "**Independent Expert's Report**") and the policyholder information booklet (which contains a statement setting out the terms of the Guernsey Scheme and a summary of the Independent Expert's Report) are available for inspection (and, in the case of the Independent Expert's Report and policyholder information booklet, for collection) during office hours at the offices of the parties' Advocates at the address set out below. These and other documents relating to the Guernsey Scheme (including actuarial reports and sample copies of the communications to policyholders) are also available on RLL and ReAssure's joint website at www.reassure.co.uk/RL-transfer and via the telephone number or address set out below.

The Application is due to be heard before the Royal Court of Guernsey, St Peter Port, Guernsey on 16 December 2016 at 09h30 and any person (including any member of RLL or ReAssure) who thinks that he or she would be adversely affected by the carrying out of the Guernsey Scheme may attend the hearing in person or by Counsel. Any person intending to attend is requested to give notice of such intention as soon as possible and preferably before 2 December 2016, setting out their grounds of objection, to ReAssure by calling the above number, writing to the address above or to the Advocates named below or sending a message via RLL and ReAssure's joint website.

Any person who objects to the Guernsey Scheme but does not intend to attend the hearing may also make representations about the Guernsey Scheme by giving notice of such representations, as soon as possible and preferably before 2 December 2016, to ReAssure by calling the above number, writing to the address above or to the Advocates named below, or sending a message via RLL and ReAssure's joint website.
