PUBLIC INQUIRY INTO THE LAND USE PLAN 2017

Take notice that I, Michael Hurley, being the Inspector appointed by the President of the States of Alderney in accordance with the Building & Development Control (Alderney) Law, 2002, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that I will hold an INQUIRY into the Land Use Plan and the alterations or addition to the Land Use Plan proposed by the Building and Development Control Committee at the Anne French Room, Island Hall, Royal Connaught Square, commencing at 0930 am on Monday 4th SEPTEMBER 2017, and expect to continue thereafter at the same times each day during the working week until Friday 22 September 2017. I will issue a notice of the detailed Inquiry timetable after the public representations and objections have been received, on 14th August 2017.

Any person or persons wishing to make a representation or offer an objection to the Plan may do so:

- (a) in person;
- (b) by an Advocate of the Royal Court of Guernsey; or
- (c) by any other person authorised to do so, or
- (d) by written representation

Section 27(3) requires that no person may, at the Planning Inquiry, make any representation, or offer any objection, in relation to a Land Use Plan unless he, or some other person acting on his behalf and described in (b) or (c) above, has, no later than ten days before to the commencement of the Inquiry has given **written notice** to me of their intention to make the representation or offer the objection. Such notice,

- (a) shall give an explanation of the proposed representation or objection sufficient to enable me to understand the essence of it; and
- (b) shall be published in the Alderney Official Gazette (if there is time before the commencement of the Inquiry) exhibited on the notice board outside the Alderney Court House and made available for inspection in the States Office.

Such written notice, representations and objections should be made by noon on 14th August 2017, addressed to:
