123/2017 Matters Arising

115.1 Committee feedback from Chairmen (B&DCC, GSC, ALG & Tourism) & Guernsey Representatives

BDCC - The Committee noted a verbal report from the Deputy Chairman of BDCC, which included reference to the threat of legal action over the potential future decisions by the States.

GSC – The Committee noted a verbal update from the Chairman of GSC, including the reference to the Inter-island freight contract. The Chairman of P&F expressed a view that unless there was good reason he would wish to see the contract made public.

External Relations – The Committee noted the update from the Chairman on a recent meeting of the All Party Parliamentary Channel Island Group at which Alderney, Guernsey and Jersey were represented.

Tourism – The Committee received a copy of the recent Accommodation Sector Group update and noted a verbal update from the Tourism lead on various matters including guesthouse accommodation, postcodes, laundry facilities, the nunnery accommodation and non-licenced accommodation providers.

It also commented on the potential benefits of securing a distinct Alderney internet domain name ending and postcode.

Representatives in the States of Guernsey - The Committee noted the update on matters discussed recently in the Guernsey States including the Budget, Island-wide voting and Social Security changes. It was also agreed to seek a presentation from the Committee for Health & Social Care on the future strategy for healthcare provision in Alderney.

AEL Loan – The Committee noted that AEL would be taking a commercial loan as the States of Guernsey Policy and Resources Committee had advised that they would not support agree to use of States of Alderney capital funds for a loan to a commercial company.

Legal Advice on Amendments - It was noted that Members were entitled to obtain legal advice on amendments they proposed to lay before the States. It was further noted that while it would be useful for Members to share such advice with the other Members there was no obligation on them to do so.
