Key Areas

- Checking that all rubbish is cleared and beaches are left in a clean and safe condition after States authorised public barbeques.
- Other duties as and when required.

- The ability to work in a safe and responsible manner to safeguard him/herself, colleagues, and the general public.
- To be able to visit beaches daily, with early morning cleaning at the weekends.
