NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, under section 68 of the Income Tax (Guernsey) Law, 1975, as amended, every person, whether or not liable to pay any tax, who has notified the Director of the Revenue Service that they are chargeable to tax, is required to deliver a return of their income for the calendar year 2018, by 30th November 2019 unless:

- the Director has notified the person, separately, in writing, that they don't need to, and
- the individual's circumstances haven't changed in 2018.

Companies are required to submit their 2018 return online. Individuals may also submit their 2018 return online or they can complete a paper form. The personal and company online returns may be accessed at <u>https://eforms.gov.gg/</u>. Personal paper returns are available from the States Office and can also be downloaded from <u>www.gov.gg/tax</u> under "Income tax returns".

Penalties may be imposed if the return isn't received by the due date.

If a person hasn't notified the Director that they are chargeable to income tax by 14th July in the year following the first year they became so chargeable, penalties may be imposed.
