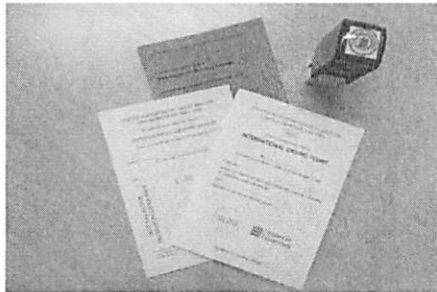




## Driving in the EU – At a Glance



International Driving Permits (IDPs) are not required for driving in the **UK, Jersey, IOM, Ireland or Switzerland**. However, IDPs are currently required for driving in most EU/EEA countries and **from 29 March 2019** the following will apply:

- 1926 IDP - Liechtenstein;
- 1949 IDP - Spain, Iceland, Malta and Cyprus;
- 1968 IDP - All other EU Countries plus Norway.

In some cases you may need more than one IDP. For example, if driving down to Spain through France then you will need a 1949 and a 1968 IDP.

*Please note this information will be updated as and when circumstances change.*

You can apply for an IDP from the Driver and Vehicle Licensing (DVL) Office at Bulwer Avenue, either by attending in person or by sending in a postal application. The application form can be downloaded here –

For each application you will be required to produce –

- A completed and signed application form;
- A passport sized photo, (two if requesting a second IDP);
- Payment of £13 per IDP.
