**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Friday 18 September 2020 at 09:30am Police Mutual Assurance Society Limited ("**Police Mutual**") and The Royal London Mutual Insurance Society Limited ("**Royal London**") intend to apply to the Royal Court of Guernsey, pursuant to section 44 of the Insurance Law, for an Order sanctioning a scheme (the "**Guernsey Scheme**") for the transfer to Royal London of the entire long term insurance businesses carried on by Police Mutual in Guernsey and all assets and liabilities attributable thereto (the "**Guernsey Business**") and for the making of ancillary provisions in connection with the implementation of the Guernsey Scheme under section 48 of the Insurance Law (the "**Application**").

The proposed transfer will result in the Guernsey Business which is currently carried on by Police Mutual being carried on by Royal London. All payments in respect of the policies comprised within the Guernsey Business shall, upon the transfer becoming effective, be dealt with by Royal London.
