


Domestic Steel Frame—Cold Bridging Detail

Purpose of this sheet

Cold bridge Information

Diagram 1 shows a technical solution to a cold bridge problem where a rectangular hollow section (RHS) is used to frame a small domestic extension. The cold bridge can be eliminated between the head of a glazed unit and the RHS if built in this way.
