I understand that bonfires are prohibited.

*I note that licences are for marriage ceremonies being held on States Land and must end no later than midnight. ****Due to the close proximity of the Campsite, there will be no licences issued during the months of July and August for functions to be held on Saye Bay or Arch Bay after 8pm.*****

I understand that temporary electricity connections shall not be used, and that the use of radios/loud speakers in public places are forbidden, under the provisions of The Noise Abatement (Alderney) Ordinance, 1962. (Should radios/ loudspeakers be required, a separate application for a Noise Abatement Licence should be submitted a minimum of 1 month before the date of the function.)

I understand that should fireworks be required, a separate application for a fireworks licence should be submitted a minimum of 1 month before the date of the function.

I am over 18 years of age.

I enclose a deposit of £75.00, which will be refunded after inspection of the site is left clear. (Please allow until at least midday of the following working day before collecting the deposit to allow time for inspections to take place. Note: Office opening hours are Monday to Friday 0900hrs – 1230hrs & 1400hrs – 1600hrs).

I am aware that the Police are informed of every licence granted and that they have powers to deal with any breach of the criminal law, including noise nuisance and behaviour contrary to the provisions of The Summary Offences (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1982.
