
COVID-19: Daily Cases Update

Following a second wave, peak Alderney positive case numbers have significantly reduced with only one current known case on the island. This is not community seeded and the individual is in isolation.

As a result of this continued downward trend, the States of Alderney will no longer be publishing online its own daily update of case numbers in Alderney and how COVID is affecting services from Wednesday 11th August 2021. Daily updates will continue for the whole Bailiwick and be officially provided by the States of Guernsey, social media platforms and their website: <https://covid19.gov.gg/test-results>

In the event of an increase in confirmed positive cases, the States of Alderney, Civil Contingencies Authority and Public Health Services will reassess this decision in providing its own daily updates.

COVID-19 Symptoms

Children and over 80s - loose stool, mild fever, not themselves with a cough presenting later.

*Some younger people with the Delta Variant are presenting with headache, sore throat and a runny nose.

 Headache, sore throat & a runny nose*	 A fever	 Conjunctivitis	 Chest pain or pressure (call 999)
 Loss of smell or taste	 Aches and Pains (recent onset)	 Diarrhoea	 Loss of speech or movement (call 999)
 A new persistent cough	 Tiredness (recent onset)	 Sore throat	 Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath (call 999)
 A new persistent cough	 Headache (sinus pain, pain around eyes)	 A rash on skin, or discolouration of fingers or toes (call your GP today for a clinical assessment)
