<u>Item IV</u> <u>The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment)</u> Regulations, 2013

The States resolved that "The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Regulations, 2013" not be annulled.

<u>Item V</u> <u>The States of Alderney Pension Scheme</u>

The States resolved:-

- To accept the recommendation in respect of a structured withdrawal from Aviva using four alternative fund managers to take on the Aviva role, spreading the investments accordingly, and making the necessary administrative changes, meanwhile investing 2013 contributions with Investec.
- 2. To amend the rules in respect of pension payments to younger spouses.
- 3. To fund the pension of all retiring members by drawdown from the Scheme until further notice.
- 4. To approve the formation of a new Defined Contribution Scheme to be administered by BWCI.
