## The Public Holidays (Alderney)

## Ordinance, 2021

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2021, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46 of, and paragraph (o) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 2004<sup>a</sup>, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

## Public holidays in 2022: Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee.

- (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1(d) of the Public Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 1988<sup>b</sup> ("the 1988 Ordinance"), Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2022 shall not be a public holiday.
- (2) Without prejudice to the provisions of the 1988 Ordinance, 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2022 and 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 shall be public holidays.

## Citation and commencement.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Holidays (Alderney) Ordinance, 2021 and shall come into force on the date it is approved by the States of Alderney.
