Emergency Procedures Part IV A Government of Alderney Law, 2004

I have today received the following representations from the Civil Contingency Authority:-

"The Authority has noted that since the representations it gave on 22nd December 2021, the number of positive cases of COVID-19 in the Bailiwick has decreased significantly from the peak over the Christmas period. As a result, the risks of person-to-person transmission are reducing and although the need to continue to follow advice on living responsibly with COVID-19, including taking a lateral flow test before attending large or crowded/close gatherings where ventilation may be poor and the use of face coverings remains, the Authority, in its press release of 18th January 2022, has confirmed a programme to de-escalate the mitigations and this will include easing its previous strong advice for people to work from home wherever practicable from 24th January 2022.

Therefore in accordance with Section 55A(4) of the Government of Alderney Law, 2004, the Authority is satisfied that in light of the prevailing situation in Alderney its representations of 22nd December 2021 no longer prevail."

In accordance with S55A(4) of 'The Government of Alderney Law, 2004', I have determined that the provisions of Part IV A of the said Act shall no longer apply from 00.01am on Monday 24th January 2022.
