Item IV Questions and Reports

The President reported on the events attended during the month. It was noted that Mr Peter Arnold had received his MBE from the Lieutenant Governor on the 11th June at the annual Garden Party.

The President, the Greffier, Mr Willmott and Mrs Maurice had attended the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association Conference in Jersey the previous week which had proved to be most beneficial. A report would be issued in due course.

On the 16th June, the President had attended the induction of the new Bailiff, Mr Geoff Rowland, in Guernsey.

It was also stated that today was the 65th anniversary of the day in which Judge French had summoned the Islanders and asked them to decide whether they wished to leave the Island. The boats arrived to evacuate them the following day.
