<u>Item I Alderney Commission for Renewable Energy: Appointment of Commissioner</u>

The States resolved to approve, on the recommendation of the Policy and Finance Committee and in accordance with section 6 of the Renewable Energy (Alderney) Law, 2007, the appointment for a further period of two years of Professor John V Sharp a Member of the Alderney Commission for Renewable Energy.

Item II Compulsory Purchase of land at the Airport (AY 1619)

The States resolved to approve to acquire by purchase:

- (a) all that freehold property registered on the Alderney Land Register under title number AY1619; and
- (b) to serve notice on the owner of the land pursuant to and in accordance with section 1(2) of The Compulsory Purchase (Alderney) Law, 1986.

Item III The Companies (Alderney) (Amendment) Law, 2012

The States resolved to approve the Projet de Loi entitled "The Companies (Alderney) (Amendment) Law, 2012" and to request the President to seek the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council for it to have the force of Law in the Island of Alderney.

Item IV Roads Contract

The States resolved to approve that the biennial contract is offered to Ronez Limited, based on the tendered schedule of rates in accordance with the tender documents, up to the value of £250,000 from the 2012 Capital Account.
