	i) Loan to "Rock the Rock"	Robert "Dougal" Bohan requested a loan (grant) in order to place a deposit on the marquee. MB suggested a loan from the Tourism budget however, CE suggested it was a decision for the Finance Committee and would check accordingly. N.B. "Rock the Rock" has now set up a trust fund for any future events.	CE

ii) GoogleEarth	MB suggests a better photo cache and map listing to be available on GoogleEarth. Suggested that AF contact Lliam O'Toole to discuss business tagging (c.f. Gloria's Food) and CE suggested AF contact Kate at BAT to implement this at the proposed Economic Development workshop in June. AF stated the intention of a campaign to get Alderney on the map.	AF
iii) Licencing issues	MB advised that the current laws for morning opening hours mean that public houses cannot open before 10am. Therefore a licenced restaurant would fall into the same category which could cause issues for certain establishments who open before 10am.	
iv) Licensee consultation	Sarah Kelly (SK) has told MB that certain licensing issues require updating (e.g. special licence has a 42 day waiting period). MB to consult with SK for a list of laws that could be refreshed. A general public opinion might be worth obtaining. CR queried the Duty Rates. MB stated that the pre-1990 discounted rate no longer stands and that it would be non-negotiable if we were to ask for a reversal.	МВ
v) Duty Free concession	MB reported that a local Off-Licence had mentioned issues with over-zealous Customs and Excise authority. CE confirmed that Alderney does not grant Duty Free concessions, just the right to apply.

vi) Light Industrial provision	A local business has raised the issue of premises for expansion. Potential could be there to relocate Public Works and encourage small industrial units to tie-in in one space. Berry's Quarry was suggested as a location but would require substantial investment. ix) Business Occupiers Rates	MB suggested the possibility of a change to business rates to encourage businesses. Potential for it as a new business incentive – and it would show willingness from the SoA. It would be necessary to clearly demonstrate the gains elsewhere in order to enable the cuts. Could un-let property be made available for new businesses? CE confirmed that the Occupiers Rates cuts would be a Policy decision.
