NOTICE

R GRAY, DIRECTOR OF INCOME TAX, GIVES NOTICE that, under section 68 of the Income Tax (Guernsey) Law, 1975, as amended, every person, whether or not liable to pay any tax, who has notified him that they are chargeable to tax, is required to deliver to him a return of their income for the calendar year 2014, by 30 November 2015 unless:

- the Director has notified the person, separately, that they need not do so, and
- the conditions under which such notification was given have continued to be satisfied throughout 2014.

Companies are required to submit their 2014 return online. Individuals may also submit their 2014 return online unless they choose to do so in non-electronic form, in which case paper returns may be obtained from the States Office.

Penalties may be imposed if the return is not received by the due date.

The personal and company online returns may be accessed at https://eforms.gov.gg/, and paper personal returns may be downloaded from http://www.gov.gg/personaltaxreturns, with effect from 2 January 2015. Paper personal returns are also expected to be available from 2 January 2015.

EMPLOYERS

You must return your fourth quarter 2014 contribution schedules with payment by NO LATER than 15 January 2015.

A 2½% penalty is applied to all late payments.

SELF & NON EMPLOYED

You must return your fourth quarter 2014 card by NO LATER than 15 January 2015.
Remember to read the notes on the card before returning.
