NOTICE

A reminder notice to owners and occupiers of property adjoining the public highway:

Owners and occupiers of property adjoining the public highway (roads & footways) are reminded of their legal requirement to cut back trees or vegetation which overhangs the public highway to cause damage, obstruction or be a health and safety hazard to persons or vehicles using the public highway. Those affected by this notice shall inspect their property regularly and ensure their obligation is fulfilled at all times. It should be noted that the States may take enforcement action upon anyone not complying with this requirement. Such action can involve the States undertaking the work and recovering from the owner/occupier any such costs incurred and/or imposing a fine of up to £500. Cooperation in complying with this matter would therefore be appreciated.
