1. The Applicants intend to apply to the Royal Court of Guernsey at The Royal Court House, St Peter Port, Guernsey (the **Royal Court**) on 12 February 2016 at 9:30 am for the sanction pursuant to Section 44 of the Insurance Law by the Royal Court of a scheme (the **Scheme**) providing for the transfer to the Transferee of certain long term insurance business of the Transferor, including in respect of Guernsey-resident policyholders and policies governed by Guernsey law.
2. Copies of (i) the proposed application; and (ii) the report of an independent actuary (the **Report**) are available for inspection (or for collection free of charge) at all reasonable times at the offices of Mourant Ozannes at the address given below.
