11.2 <u>Connaught Extension Phase 2</u> – Report from Mr Gentle dated 20th February 2020 tabled and noted. Mr Jean declared a pecuniary interest and took no part in the discussion or vote.

The Policy & Finance Committee resolved to approve and recommend to the full States funds of:

• £400,000 for delivery of Phase 2 Substructure & Grounds of the Connaught Extension Project; and

- £1.29 million for the delivery of Phase 3 of the project on completion of Phase 2 to provide for additional resident accommodation within an extension to the Connaught Care Home.
- To request that the Chairman writes to the President to include the above on the Billet D'Etat for the States meeting in March 2020; and
- To request that the Chairman prepares a letter with summary business case for consideration and approval by the States of Guernsey Policy & Resources Committee at the same time.

12/2020 Matters Arising 12.1 Committee feedback from Chairmen (BDCC, GSC, Finance & Tourism) & Guernsey Representatives

BDCC – BDCC meeting last Thursday

GSC – Next meeting Tuesday next week. Harbour survey may be followed by a meeting with stakeholders.

Finance – no matters to bring to P&F at this stage

Alderney Representatives in the States of Guernsey – A request was made that Policy & Finance should ask the Alderney Representatives to support the ESCC in the States of Deliberation debate about the future of education. P&F resolved unanimously to do so. Potential for questions to President of STSB at the next States meeting.

CTED – Mr Earl is now Chairman of the TED Committee; The Chamber of Commerce letter has had a response and Mr Earl has met with them. The Blonde Hedgehog has been awarded five stars. Ms Burgess expressed her disappointment about the way some States Members responded to the Chamber of Commerce without consulting the Committee members responsible.

12.2 External Relations

APPCIG meeting – a concern was expressed that the States of Guernsey appeared to seek advance notice of what the States of Alderney representatives might be presenting to the Meeting.

Future Partnership Delivery Group (now Future Relationship Delivery Group) Mr Dent attended via telephone conference. A concern was expressed that Channel Islands needs are not being fully taken into account in the UK.

A decision to turn down change from commercial to residential has raised issues about the TRP level. A request was made to look at options for the future Single Property Tax.
