# 131/2017 Matters Arising

# 131.1 <u>Committee feedback from Chairmen (B&DCC, GSC, ALG & Tourism) & Guernsey Representatives</u>

**BDCC** - The Committee noted a verbal update from the Deputy Chairman of BDCC on the ongoing progress of the legislative changes

**133.8** <u>Major Projects Criteria</u> – Report from Chief Executive dated 30<sup>th</sup> November 2017 tabled and noted.

The Committee agreed, by a majority with Messrs Barnes and Tugby dissenting and Mr Roberts abstaining, that it would seek evidence on which to base its recommendation to the States and that its submission should include:

- 1. A baseline study conducted professionally, supplemented by an assessment of the economic and social impact of the development proposals; and
- 2. Reference to relevant States approved economic or social policies; and
- 3. Reference to relevant constitutional or legislative matters where this is appropriate; and
- 4. A view based on the above explaining why the Committee considers the proposals to be in the best long terms interests of Alderney and of strategic importance.

And furthermore that it would support safeguards being included within the Ordinance such that:

- The report accompanying the resolution of the P&F Committee should provide a map with identification of the site proposed, a summary explanation of the proposed project and comment on its anticipated benefit to Alderney, to assist the public in understanding the proposed development or other work; and
- 2. The proposed recommendation to be presented to the States should be published for a minimum period of 12 days before the matter is debated by the States; and
- 3. The P&F Committee in its recommendations to the States may request that the BDCC subject the subsequent planning application to a Public Inquiry.
- 4. The P&F be required to invite feedback from the community as part of its decision making process.
