### 65/2020 Matters Arising

65.1 <u>Any relevant comments from Chairmen (re BDCC, GSC, CfTED & Finance), & Guernsey</u> <u>Representatives</u>

BDCC: the Committee noted the update provided by the Deputy Chairman, BDCC on recent high profile applications and the policy discussions about housing needs, trees generally and BDCC's LUP monitoring annual statement for the December States.

**GSC:** The Committee noted the report from the Chairman on recent GSC discussions with a particular interest in Whitegates and the need for a decision. It also discussed Fort Doyle and coastal erosion by the Arsenal, the issues over traffic in the town area and the Marina concept was being explored further with discussions with the developer.

**CfTED:** The Committee noted the report from the Chairman on recent matters including heritage sites, small business grants, campsite, cannabis production and export issues, meeting with Guernsey officers regarding revive and thrive. The Committee was also continuing to discuss economic opportunities.

**Finance:** The Committee noted the report from the Chairman of Finance on recent activities including grant applications agreed based on need following reviews of the level of reserves held by the grant applicants. The committee also reviewed various matters including an application for grant funding for mental health services, deferred pending wider strategic consideration, and support for the ABO which was referred back to GSC. In addition, matters such as the Swimming Pool funding and numismatics were discussed.

**Alderney Reps:** The Committee noted the report from the Alderney representatives including the recent budget discussions. It was also noted that Deputy Mark Helyar the Policy & Resources Committee's liaison for Alderney would be visiting the Island on Friday.

65.2 <u>External Relations including update on Fisheries 'Permissive Extent Clause'</u> The Chairman provided an update on the EU/UK and CD negotiations and also provided an update on the Channel Island All Party Parliamentary Group discussions. It was also agreed to invite the President to provide updates as an when he had dialogue with members of the UK parliament.

### 66/2020 Legislation, Conventions, Policy & Finance

**66.1** <u>Employment Law & Minimum Wage</u> – Report from Chris Brock dated 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020 tabled and considered.

The Policy & Finance Committee resolved

- to draw attention to the fact it had previously agreed to introduce contract of employment legislation; and
- to request the Law Officers draft the necessary contract of employment legislation, subject to confirmation that the Guernsey Industrial disputes tribunal would be prepared to deal with Alderney cases, and
- to agree that the introduction of minimum wage be deferred to be a subsequent phase to the Contract of Employment Law, and
- not to seek at the moment any employment related legislation in respect of Maternity Leave and Sex Discrimination.

**66.2** <u>Alderney Employment Permit Law Review/Change</u> - Report from Law Officer Roy Lee dated 21st October 2020 tabled and considered, along with a draft regulation tabled during the discussion.

The Policy & Finance Committee resolved:-

- to request the Guernsey Policy Resources Committee implement the draft regulation using its Brexit Emergency powers to effect an urgent amendment to the employment permit legislation to ensure it did not discriminate on grounds of nationality; and
- to seek a review of the employment permit legislation considering whether it required further changes to make it appropriate for Alderney's current needs and to ensure compliance with other legislation and conventions.

**66.3** <u>Future Work on WW2 Issues</u> – Report from Chief Executive dated 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020 tabled and considered.

The Policy & Finance Committee resolved:-

- To note that the views in the paper were those of the Chief Executive who had not advised the Chairman or the Temporary Chief Executive of its submission; and
- To seek to ascertain how the item came to be on the agenda for this meeting, and
- To seek an update from the BDCC on its policy work to safeguard sites of historic interest, and
- by a majority with Messrs Gentle, Jean and Snowdon dissenting, to agree that, given the issues identified were important, the report be returned to the agenda for consideration following further research under the direction of the temporary Chief Executive and for this to include seeking the advice of the Law Officers.
