The Traffic (Amendment)

Regulations, 2022

Made	6 th December, 2022
Coming into operation	19 th December, 2022
Laid before the States	, 2022

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 2 and 35 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966¹ and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Amendment of the Traffic Regulations, 1986.

1. (1) The Traffic Regulations, 1986^2 are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 2A, for "the Schedule" in each place where it occurs, substitute "Schedule Two".

(3) For regulation 13(1)(a), substitute "on the public highways listed in

Schedule Three, at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour, and".

(4) In regulation 14(1), for "the schedule" in each place where it occurs, substitute "Schedule One".

(5) In regulation 19(1), in the definition for ""**disc zone**" or "**disc parking zone**"", for "the Schedule" substitute "Schedule One".

(6) After Schedule Two, insert the Schedule to these Regulations.

Citation and commencement.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 2022 and come into force on the 19th December, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Traffic Regulations, 1986 to impose a 15 miles per hour speed limit on parts of Route de Crabby and the entire length of Braye Street.
