Item II **The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.14) Regulations, 2021.**

The States of Alderney noted “The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No.14) Regulations, 2021”.

Item III **The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2022**

The States of Alderney noted “The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2022”.

Item IV **Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022**

The States of Alderney noted “The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (General Provision) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022”.

Item V **The Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Amendment) Law, 2021**

The States of Alderney resolved to approve the draft Projet de Loi entitled “The Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Amendment) Law, 2021” and to authorise the Bailiff to present a most humble petition to Her Majesty praying for Royal Sanction thereto.

Item VI **Amendment to the Alderney Beneficial Ownership (BO) Law and the Companies Law**

The States of Alderney resolved to approve “The Beneficial Ownership and Companies (Amendment) (Alderney) Law, 2022” and to authorise the Bailiff to present a most humble petition to Her Majesty praying for Her Royal Sanction thereto.

Item VII **The Alderney eGambling (Amendment) Regulations, 2021**

The States of Alderney resolved not to annul “The Alderney eGambling (Amendment) Regulations, 2021”.

Item VIII **The Speed Trials (Alderney) Ordinance, 2022**

The President stated that he had been advised of a small amendment to this item in that the commencement date should be 16th March 2022 and not 12th January 2022. He added that as this amendment was considered ‘de minimus’ it was sufficient to simply have the date changed on the document.

The States of Alderney resolved to approve “The Speed Trials (Alderney) Ordinance, 2022”.

Item IX **Change to the Rules of Procedure for States Committees**

The States of Alderney resolved to approve that Rule 19 in the Rules of Procedure for States Committees be removed and the sequential numbering of the Rules be amended accordingly.

Item X **Code of Conduct Amendment**

The States of Alderney resolved to approve the amendment to the Code of Conduct for States Members by adding sub Paragraph 12.5:-

“12.5 In the event that the President is unable to appoint a hearing panel from the existing members, he may, with the agreement of the secretary to the Guernsey Code of Conduct Panel, appoint temporary members from the Guernsey Panel having consulted with the Chair or the Vice Chair of the Policy and Finance Committee.”

Item XI **Questions and Reports**

Question from Mr Gentle for the two representatives on the States of Deliberation:-

- Could our two Alderney Representatives briefly summarise any matters of importance to Alderney that may have been debated recently in the Guernsey States of Deliberation?

Questions from Mr Snowdon for the Chairman of Policy & Finance Committee:-

1. Does the Chairman have any updates about the future of ACRE and what is happening with any obligations the regulator may need to perform?
2. Please will the Chairman give his view and opinion about how the recent runway drop-in was received by the public and P&F?
3. Does the Chairman have any details he could share about Alderney - Guernsey ferry service including start and end dates?
4. Could you explain what is happening with the accommodation available at the Nunnery?
5. Would the Chairman like to outline the funding support from the States to the Ukraine appeal and his views about local fundraising from Alderney's community, such as the recent concert?

Questions from Mr Snowdon for the Chairman of General Services Committee:-

1. Could the Chairman update members and the public about the current situation regarding our Ambulance service?
2. Is the States likely to introduce dashcams in all States of Alderney drivable machinery and vehicles?
3. Would the GSC Chairman be able to explain what happened to the Alderney Maritime Trust, which I believe safeguarded and protected wrecks in our waters?
