**The Animal Health (Infected Area) (Avian Influenza)
(Alderney) Order, 2022**

THE GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE –

- (a) aware that Avian Influenza, a notifiable animal disease, has occurred in the Island of Alderney, and
- (b) being of the opinion that in the interests of animal health throughout and beyond this Island the disease ought to be contained within this Island,

in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 14 and 33 of the Animal Health (Alderney) Ordinance, 2002^a, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

Declaration of infected area.

1. The Island of Alderney is declared to be an infected area in respect of Avian Influenza.

Citation and Commencement.

2. (1) This Order may be cited as the Animal Health (Infected Area) (Avian Influenza) (Alderney) Order, 2022.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 22nd August, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order declares the Island of Alderney an infected area in respect of Avian Influenza. This Order is made under the Animal Health (Alderney) Ordinance, 2002.

On this declaration coming into force, restrictions in the Ordinance apply to the movement, watering, grazing and removal of animals susceptible to Avian Influenza, including the movement of these animals into or out of the Island of Alderney.

This Order comes into force on the 22nd August 2022.
