**4.1 Formalising Future Working Relationships Between the Alderney and Guernsey Public Services** – Letter from Deputy Helyar dated 16<sup>th</sup> October tabled and discussed.

The Policy & Resources Committee and the Policy and Finance Committee respect and understand the constitutional relationships between Guernsey and Alderney and the special, and long-standing, relationship through the Bailiwick.
