**01/07/2021**    **Emergency Preparedness in Alderney** – Report from Chief Executive dated 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021 tabled and considered.

Today the Borders of the Bailiwick are open to travellers according to the latest Emergency Regulations. Much work has been done to ensure our ports of entry (airport and harbour) are set up to handle travellers according to the latest requirements. There remains, at this moment, a low level risk of infections being brought in and those with symptoms needing to self-isolate. We have arrangements in place for those with a home here to self-isolate.

For the remaining visitors who have symptoms and test positive in visitor accommodation that has shared bathrooms, kitchens, including hostel and camping venues, it means they will need a suitable place to self-isolate.

**The Policy and Finance Committee resolved to approve in principal, the allocation of monies up to £10k from the Economic Development Fund for the CE to pursue securing an isolation facility (option 3.1 set out in the report) where in the short term, and return to P&F with options for isolation facilities up to the end of 2021.**
